The current Climate & Resiliency Commission (CRC) members will select no more than 5 Junior Commissioners at their April 16, 2025 meeting. The CRC meets bi-monthly on Wednesdays from $5:30\ PM-7:00\ PM$. Please check the website for the most up to date calendar.

Junior Commissioners will be able to attend meetings and provide input on any of the agenda items. They may propose projects they would like to implement at their schools or communities that relate to the work of the CRC. They will witness how global environmental policy issues are addressed at the local level. Appointments will be for a one-year term. If an appointment happens mid-year due to a vacancy, the new appointment will serve the remainder of that one-year term.
