B. PUBLIC HEARINGS: (8.1.)

This portion of the agenda provides citizens an opportunity to express their views on a specific issue as required by law after proper noticing by submitting a speaker slip (located on the back table) to the City Clerk. After considering all of the evidence, including written materials and oral testimony, the City Council must make a decision supported by findings and the findings must be supported by substantial record. An applicant or designees for evidence in the development/business project, for which the public hearing is being held, is allotted a total of fifteen minutes to speak, as per SBMC 2.04.210. A portion of the fifteen minutes may be saved to respond to those who speak in opposition. All other speakers have three minutes each. Please be aware of the timer light on the Council Dais.

B.1 500 Block of South Sierra Avenue: 1) Development Review Permit (DRP),
Structure Development Permit (SOP), Density Bonus, Parking Ratio, and
Incentive for City-Owned Property in the 500 Block of South Sierra Avenue;
Applicant: Hitzke Development Corporation (Case# 17-11-05) 2) Development,
Disposition, and Loan Agreement (DDLA) for Development of Affordable
Housing. (File 0600-10)

The proposed project meets the minimum objective requirements under the SBMC, is consistent with the General Plan, and may be found, as conditioned, to meet the discretionary findings required as discussed in this report to approve a DRP and administratively issue a SOP. It will meet the City's commitment to provide 10 units of affordable replacement housing. Therefore, Staff recommends that the City Council:

- 1. Conduct the Public Hearing: Open the Public Hearing, Report Council Disclosures, Receive Public Testimony, and Close the Public Hearing.
- 2. Find the project exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Class 32 "Infill Development Project" of the State CEQA Guidelines.

- 3. Approve Resolution 2014-039, making the requisite findings to conditionally approve a Development Review Permit (DRP); an administrative Structure Development Permit (SOP); a density bonus; the use of vehicular parking ratio for the residential component as provided in Government Code Section 65915(p); an incentive to waive the development standard in the Highway 101 Corridor Specific Plan that limits the residential component of a mixed use development to 40 percent or less of the total as required by State law; and approval of a categorical exemption to construct a mixed-use development on a City-owned, 14,721 square foot site in the 500 block of South Sierra Avenue.
- 4. If the City Council conditionally approves the project as per Items 1-3 above, approve Resolution 2014-040, approving the Development, Disposition, and Loan Agreement for the development of affordable housing and authorizing the City Manager to sign the DDLA and associated documents on behalf of the City.
