MEETINGS

MEMBERS

The Commission consists of nine (9) members as follows:

- Residents: Five (5) members shall be residents of the City of Solana Beach.
- Professionals: Two (2) members shall be from the environmental and/or scientific community. The residency requirement of Chapter 2.60 does not apply to these two members.
- Councilmembers: Two (2) current Councilmembers.

All members are appointed by the Council At-Large. Each position is a two-year term. For additional city-wide commission member requirements refer to Solana Beach Municipal Code 2.60. *It is recommended that potential future applicants attend a Commission meeting prior to being considered for an appointment.*

Advisory Members:

Additional advisory members may be appointed to the Commission by the City Council, including residents and non-residents, with specific professional or scientific expertise. These members would not have voting privileges but could be key advisors to the Commission by bringing their expertise, knowledge and experience to the process.

DUTIES

The Climate & Resiliency Commission will focus on specific issues surrounding the implementation of the City's Climate Action Plan including mitigation measures, adaptation and resiliency measures, and incorporating equity.
